Action for trademark infringement.

This case involved a trademark dispute between two competitors in the business of placement of temporary and permanent radiation therapy professionals. Rapid Temps, our client, was a small, highly successful company using the name Rapid Temps and RT. The Plaintiff's case was based primarily on alleged actual confusion and won by Defendants on cross-examination on that issue.

Plaintiff was represented by Eugene Renz of Media, Pennsylvania and Paul E. Crawford of Connelly, Bove & Lodge of Delaware.

The case went to trial in Philadelphia before a jury and a verdict was obtained in favor of defendant, Rapid Temps, Inc. in July 1998.
